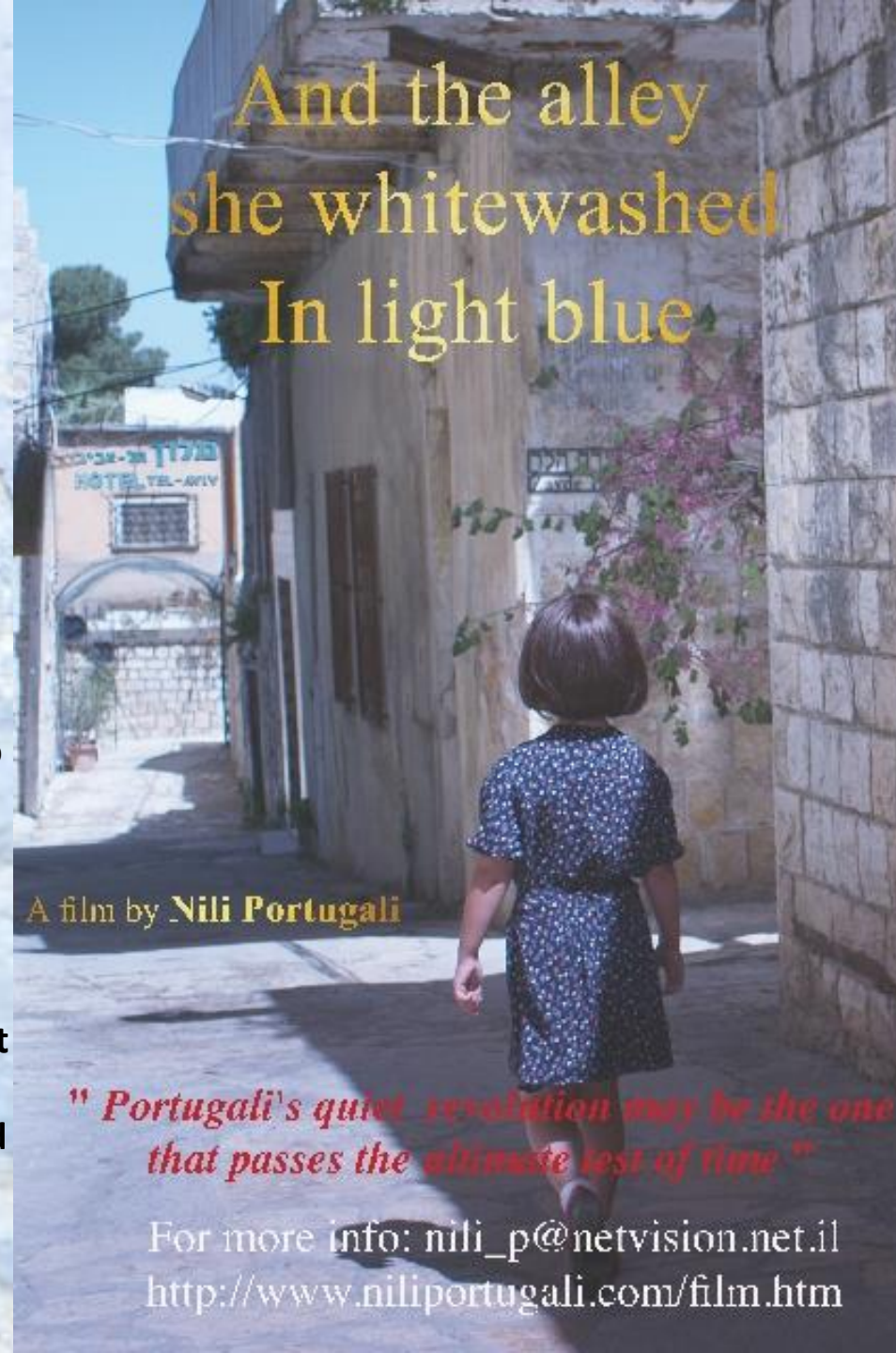
At a time of existential threat to the physical and human environment, Architect Portugali takes us into a deeply intimate journey in the Kabbala holy city of
